### Instructions manual

1. In this system, parents can have control over five aspects: Application management, Internet filtering, time management, data statistics and multimedia management.

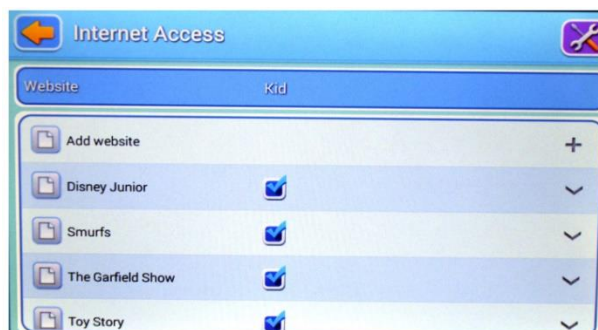
#### (1) Application management

This application allows parents to choose the right installed application for their children. See the following:



#### (2) Internet filter

This application has been designed to provide an Internet filter for children, so that it can be under parental control. See the following:



#### (3) Time Management

This application can restrict children's tablet usage time.

There are two sections:

1. Restrict children's daily usage time
2. Restrict children's weekly usage time.

#### (4) Data statistics

In the statistics, parents can clearly recognise not only the specific usage, but also the usage habit of the children. See below:



#### (5) Multimedia management

In multimedia management, parents can add music, images and videos for children, so that children can open the associated programme in the children's panel and immediately enjoy these contents. In addition, all children can share those files. See the following:

### (1) The main parent panel

## 3. Features

### (1) Automatic operation

The control system can operate automatically when the tablet is rebooted.



## (2) Multiple account management

Parents can set up a disposable account for children, so that parents can conveniently supervise their children.

Parents can choose the apps selected here for children.

These apps will be updated regularly, so that children will receive the latest and most popular recommendations.



## (4) Customise children's environment

Children can change the background image, application frame and login image.



#### **(5) Exit**

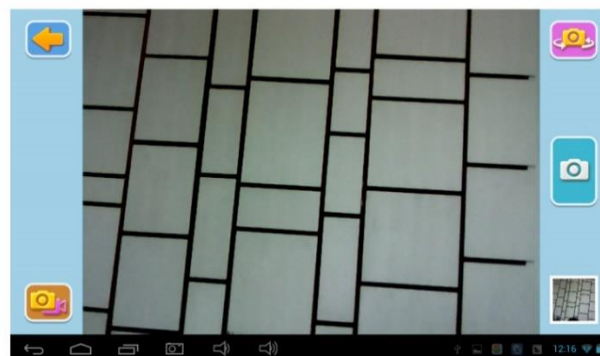
When parents have to deal with an emergency, they can exit the children's application to the main panel by pressing the exit button after entering the password.




## Parental Dashboard

(2-5) Access the data statistics application to view data in percentage and time of children's account usage.



(2-6) Enter the system configuration application, edit system information and settings. This information also applies to the children's account.
